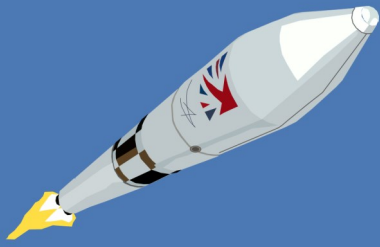

Build and launch your own rockets!



Super Easy-To-Make Water Rocket

Step 1: Obtain a 2 litre sparkling water bottle. The simpler the shape the better.



Step 2: Carefully cut an old or super-cheap tennis ball in half and attach to the bottom of the bottle with strong tape. The bottom of the bottle is now the top of your rocket.

“tabs” or “flanges” for securing to the rocket

Rocket fins x 3 or 4 evenly spaced around the rocket.

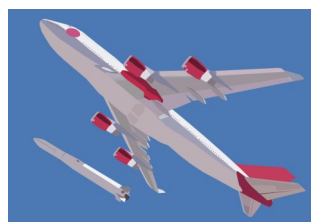
Step 3: Design and cut out cardboard fins to add stability in flight. Make sure to add “tabs” or “flanges” to allow you to easily secure the fins to the bottle. Space them evenly around your rocket.

Step 4: Remove the plastic ring under the bottle cap if using the Full-bore rocket launcher. Keep the bottle cap for ease of re-fuelling and moving fuelled rockets around.

Step 5: SAFETY FIRST! Make sure you follow the safety instructions for your chosen rocket launcher method.



NOTE: Bicycle pump sold separately. Track pump or foot pump recommended.,
